

Yamaha Studio Manager V2.3.1 for Windows Release Note

Main Revisions and Enhancements

V2.3.0 to V2.3.1

- Made it possible to return to normal operation by operations such as clicking on the desktop, when your computer froze up during the use of the menu bar. The Studio Manager infrequently froze up depending on your computer or OS, if the cursor had been moved to the title bar the moment the menu was shown, or if the mouse had been moved left or right repeatedly with the menu shown on the display.

Version History

V2.1.7 to V2.3.0

- Added the "Update Port" button. Studio Manager will search for MIDI ports that have been enabled since you last started the application.
- Added the "MIDI Thru" function.
- Changed the default save folder in Windows Vista.
- Changed a part of the window composition.
- Solved a problem in which Cubase might freeze when the Editors for OPT1 are started on Cubase.
- Solved a problem in which Bulk MIDI data might fail in transmission in Windows Vista.
- Solved a problem in which all MIDI ports in the Re-map MIDI Ports dialog might not display.
- Solved some minor errors.

V2.1.6 to V2.1.7

- Solved the remote possibility that DM2000/02R96/DM1000/01V96/SPX2000 Editor can not open when you use them in tablet PC.
